

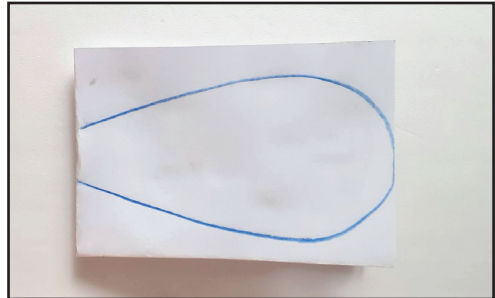
## Tiger moth instructions.

The Garden Tiger Moth has striking colour and markings. Wings with chocolate brown, orange and bright blue. Symmetrical markings on the wings. Blues/browns and hints of red on the body.

Use a fun printing method to make markings on the wings



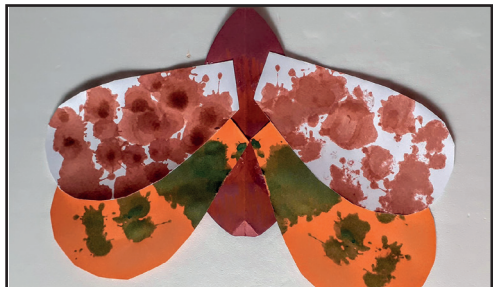
Make markings on one side of the page. Fold the page in half and rub. The wet paint will mirror print onto the other half of the page.



Fold the page in half once the print is dry and cut out a wing shape. Repeat this method with a different colour paint on the orange card.



Make fur like markings on the body of the moth.



Glue the orange wings lower on the body. Layer then glue the white wings over the orange wings.



You can use feathers for the body and cut the feathers to shape. A furry pipe cleaner for antennae, or, glue small pompom eyes. It's up to you. Add your moth to our Creepy-Crawly display. What's your moth's job in the insect world?
